Sioux City Transit System Bus Passes Available

The Neighborhood Services Division of the Community Development Department is pleased to announce the availability of Sioux City Transit System bus passes (10 ride punch card) to low-income residents of Sioux City. One pass per household per month is available to those who income qualify (less than 80% of the Area Median Income level). For example, the total annual income for a family of four could not exceed \$50,650. To qualify, the individual must also reside within Sioux City. These passes are funded by Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds.

Bus passes are available for pick-up at the Center For Siouxland office (715 Douglas Street). Those persons interested in participating must go to Center For Siouxland to fill out an income verification form and receive the bus pass in person. This is a new program that may be extended based on the need and response. Bus passes are given out on a first come, first served basis.

This program was created in response to input received during the Year 2 Action Planning public meetings held in early 2016. The City of Sioux City is pleased to partner with the Center For Siouxland and the Sioux City Transit System to provide this much needed service. Special thanks to the Center For Siouxland for providing the support necessary to start this program.
